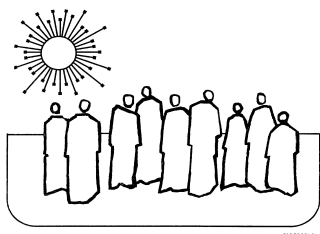

#### OUR HOPE AND GOD'S PROMISE

The Church uses these waning November days and darker skies as the season to remind us of the last things. Today's feast, the Solemnity of All Saints, is the centerpiece of three days that point to doctrines we proclaim each time we say the Apostles' Creed: "We believe in the holy catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body and life everlasting." And while the days and our hearts may be dark, the readings today are bright with the light of faith. John's vision in the book of Revelation reveals dazzling angels and white-robed saints gathered in triumph around the throne of God. In the responsorial psalm we sing our longing to see God's face, and in the second reading John writes that we are God's children and will, in fact, see God "as he is" (1 John 3:2). This is our hope. This is God's promise. Today we celebrate the triumph of those who already gaze on the face of God. Tomorrow we cry out for mercy with those in purgatory, who, like us on earth, still long to see God's face.

#### SAINT MARTIN DE PORRES (1579-1639)

##### November 3

An old illustration pictures Martin de Porres, finger to his lips—"Shhhh!"—as several mice peek out of sacristy vestment drawers, preparing to join a rodent "procession" following him out of church! Martin's rescue of these unwelcome guests, and statues depicting him, broom in hand, feeding a dog, cat, bird, and mouse from the same dish symbolize his life and sanctity. Initially denied entrance by the Dominicans because of his mixed race (Spanish father, Panamanian mother), Martin cherished society's marginalized. For him, menial tasks, lovingly done, were sacred. Great and lowly alike feasted on his charity. Enemies were reconciled by this "poor mulatto" (his self-description), kind even to those whose racism demeaned him. Apprenticed to a surgeon-barber in his youth—thus patron saint of hair stylists and public health providers—Martin dispensed healing and dignity to Lima's poorest, serving in them the Christ he adored for hours in the Blessed Sacrament. By the time he died, all Peru called him Martin the Charitable, a title even those of us who will never be called "saint" might still aspire to.

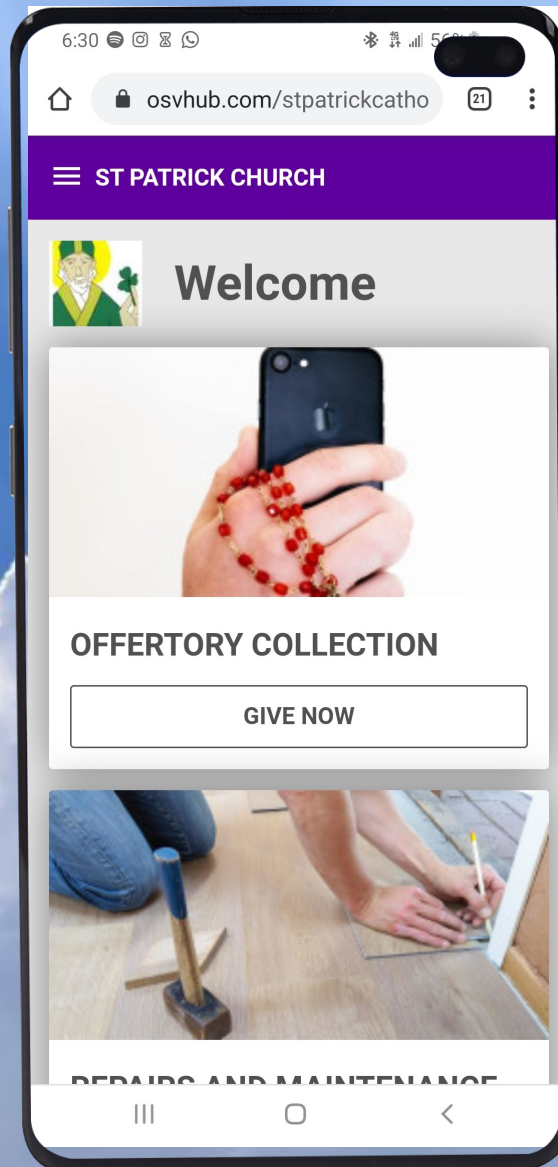

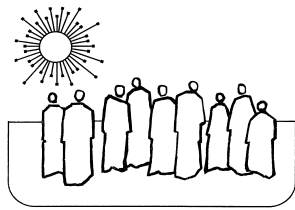

## NUESTRA ESPERANZA Y LA PROMESA DE DIOS

La Iglesia usa estos días que se acortan y los cielos oscuros como el tiempo para recordarnos las postrimerías de la vida. La fiesta de hoy, la Solemnidad de Todos los Santos, es el centro de tres días que nos presentan las doctrinas que proclamamos cada vez que rezamos el Credo de los Apóstoles: “Creemos en la Iglesia católica, la comunión de los santos, el perdón de los pecados, la resurrección de los muertos y la vida perdurable”. Y mientras que los días y nuestro corazón parezcan oscuros, las lecturas de hoy están llenas de la luz de la fe. La visión de Juan en el libro del Apocalipsis revela ángeles resplandecientes y santos con túnicas blancas reunidos triunfantemente alrededor del trono de Dios. En el salmo responsorial cantamos sobre nuestro anhelo de ver el rostro de Dios, y en la segunda lectura, Juan escribe que somos hijos de Dios y que veremos a Dios “tal como es”. Esa es nuestra esperanza. Esa es la promesa de Dios. Hoy celebramos el triunfo de aquellos que ya contemplan el rostro de Dios. Mañana clamamos para que Dios tenga misericordia de los que están en el purgatorio, quienes, al igual que los que estamos todavía en la tierra, anhelan contemplar el rostro de Dios.

### SAN MARTÍN DE PORRES (1579-1639)

#### 3 de noviembre

Martín nació en Perú, de madre africana y padre español. Debido al racismo de su tiempo, su padre los abandonó y aun así, siendo muy pobre, cuidó de los más pobres que él. A los 12 años aprendió el oficio de barbero y enfermería, oficio que desempeñó con una caridad sin par. Pidió ser admitido con los frailes menores de la orden de los Dominicos pero no lo aceptaron debido al color de su piel. Nueve años después se le permitió hacer sus votos perpetuos en la comunidad. Martín no guardaba odio para nadie, sólo amor. Puesto que además de pasar horas y horas frente al Santísimo Sacramento cuidaba de los enfermos dentro del monasterio, fuera de él y en todo Perú, la gente le llamó: “Martín de la caridad”. En su canonización el Papa Juan XXIII dijo de que se “ejercitaba inmensamente en la caridad para con sus hermanos, caridad que era fruto de su fe íntegra y de su humildad. Amaba a su prójimo porque los consideraba verdaderos hijos de Dios y hermanos suyos”. Fue canonizado en 1962.

Teens and alcohol: COVID temptations  
Families have been cooped up for months now during the COVID-19 pandemic, and studies have shown that many Americans are buying more beer and alcohol than usual to cope with related anxiety and stress. These same stresses may tempt teens and young adults to experiment with alcohol, especially if it is readily available. Talk to your children about the dangers of underage drinking, even if they plan to stay home. Model good behavior for your children, too; if you do drink alcohol, practice moderation and safe judgement. Consider locking your bar, or moving alcohol somewhere out of reach from your children. Adolescentes y alcohol: tentaciones COVID  
Las familias han estado encerradas por meses durante la pandemia de COVID-19, y los estudios han demostrado que muchos estadounidenses están comprando más cerveza y alcohol de lo habitual para hacer frente a la ansiedad y el estrés relacionados con el encierro. Estas mismas tensiones pueden tentar a los adolescentes y adultos jóvenes a experimentar con el alcohol, especialmente si está fácilmente disponible. Hable con sus hijos sobre los peligros del consumo de alcohol por menores de edad, aunque ellos tengan planes de quedarse en casa. Modele también el buen comportamiento de sus hijos; si bebe alcohol, practique la moderación y el juicio prudente. 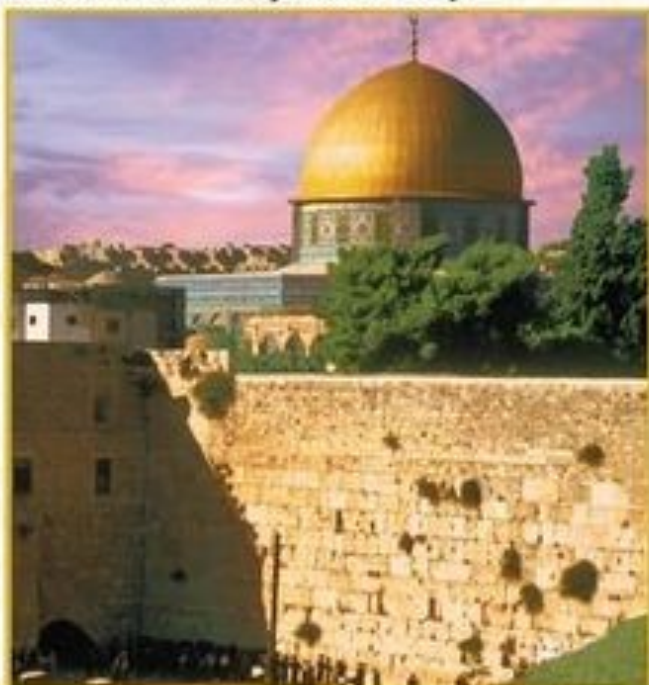
